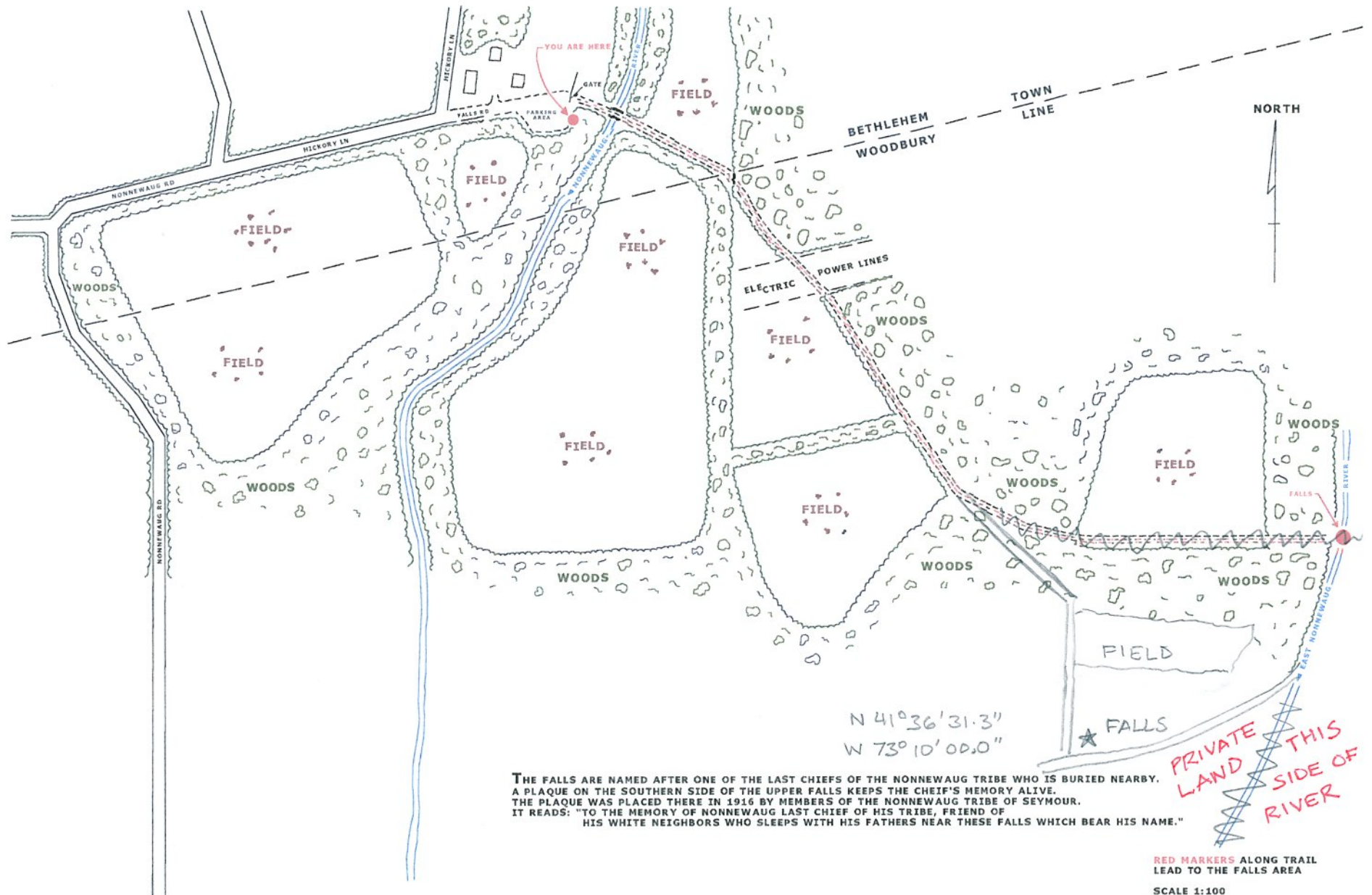


NONNEWAUG FALLS TRAIL MAP



THE FALLS ARE NAMED AFTER ONE OF THE LAST CHIEFS OF THE NONNEWAUG TRIBE WHO IS BURIED NEARBY. A PLAQUE ON THE SOUTHERN SIDE OF THE UPPER FALLS KEEPS THE CHIEF'S MEMORY ALIVE. THE PLAQUE WAS PLACED THERE IN 1916 BY MEMBERS OF THE NONNEWAUG TRIBE OF SEYMOUR. IT READS: "TO THE MEMORY OF NONNEWAUG LAST CHIEF OF HIS TRIBE, FRIEND OF HIS WHITE NEIGHBORS WHO SLEEPS WITH HIS FATHERS NEAR THESE FALLS WHICH BEAR HIS NAME."
